- If there is a \$20 difference in your invoice, that is most likely because the \$20 discount is for the **ADDITIONAL** child, not per child.

DAY CAMPERS INFO

On the **first and last day of camp**, day campers should **arrive and leave at the same time as overnight campers**.

***An earlier pick-up at 5:30 PM** is also available to accommodate working parents.

Day campers pay the same rate as overnight campers, as they participate fully in the daily program.

Monday 28 September, 2026 On Registration day please bring your camper at **11am**.

Wednesday and Thursday 29-30, 2026

The suggested drop-off time is between **8:00–8:30 AM**, and pick-up is at **8:30 PM***, aligning with the start and end of our daily program.

Thursday 1 October, 2026

The suggested drop-off time is between **8:00–8:30 AM**, and pick-up is at **2pm**, aligning with the start and end of our programme.

SIGN IN INFO

We'll be using a **drive-through sign-in process** to keep things smooth and efficient.

When you arrive, our team will direct you from the **first entrance** to the **second entrance** of camp. Please follow the signs and staff guidance.

Gates are locked till allocated time for SIGN IN/OUT so please do not come early. We have lots of moving parts in the morning and will be ready at the times indicated.*

From the Second Entrance; There will be **four quick stations** along the way:

1. **Gear Drop-Off & Cabin Info** - Please give out the campers full name
2. **Biscuits drop off, Medication sign in & First Aid Check-In**
3. **Camper Sign-In** - Please indicate who will be picking up the campers at the end of week. Please confirm your Phone Number is right.
4. **Camper Drop-Off & Goodbyes**
Please park in the indicated area. Parents are invited to come and see where the camper is sleeping, come into the dining hall for a cuppa and some morning tea or have a look around.

If you'd like a guided tour of camp, just let a Volunteer know—we'd be happy to show you around. SO many upgrades have been happening at camp. Prefer a self-guided tour? You're more than welcome to have a look around camp!

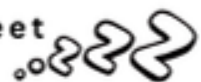

COMMUNICATION DURING CAMP

To help campers fully engage and build friendships without distractions, phones, tablets, and other electronic devices are not permitted during camp. All devices will be collected at the beginning of camp and safely stored- we prefer that campers do not bring them at all, leaving them home is preferred.

If your child has a specific need to retain their phone (e.g. for health-related reasons ie- insulin for diabetic), please speak directly with a staff member prior to camp.

Please note: During camp, our staff are hands-on with campers, so the office may not always be staffed. Email is the best way to reach us, and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

We understand that some campers may feel homesick, especially if it's their first time away. Our team is trained to gently support them through it using:

- Distraction and redirection
- Creative activities (e.g. drawing, writing letters home)
- Emotional support and comfort

If these strategies aren't effective, we will discreetly contact the parent/guardian listed on the sign-up form to discuss further steps and seek advice on how best to support your child.
